In order for a family to be eligible for the Catholic tuition rates at St. John the Baptist School, a Catholic Parish Verification form must be completed by the Catholic church that your family currently attends. This form is available to you at the school office.

St. John the Baptist School is working with SMART Tuition for collection of our families' tuition for the 2017-2018 school year. By utilizing a tuition management system, St. John's joins other Parochial schools in their efforts to better serve families, while also improving the school's cash flow. New families who will be paying monthly will receive a welcome letter with your account number and log in information. Current families will be rolled over into the new school year. Your account number and log in information will stay the same. If you have not received this information, please contact SMART's customer service which is available 24 hours a day/7 days a week. There are a couple of important points regarding this service that all parents should be aware of: SMART tuition will process tuition AND they will contact parents that have overdue balances by e-mail or telephone and make payment arrangements on behalf of the school. SMART charges a \$40.00 follow up/late fee the day after the payment is due. The \$40.00 charge will be added to the family tuition account. If you need to stop an auto payment for any reason, you must make contact SMART Tuition a minimum of three (3) days before the payment is due!

Incoming Kindergarten students will need a physical, an eye exam by an eye doctor and a dental examination. The 2017-2018 6th graders will need physicals and dental exams as well as updated immunizations. Students participating in Sports will require a Sport's Physical before they can practice or compete in any athletic activities. Second Graders will also need dental exams. All preschool students will need a physical exam form completed by a doctor.
